- Design and arrange the logistics for field trips for the group of international experts in order to conduct in-deep analysis for the hazards, elaborate maps and interview key stakeholders.
- Design, send invitations and conduct participatory risk assessment workshops at the chosen destinations
- Produce the proceedings and the analysis of the results of the participatory workshops
- Design and conduct validation process with key stakeholders on technical documents generated in this project.
- Produce a report on stakeholders' consultation
- Communicate regularly with the team leader and the team of specialist.
